

Third Year Spelling Activities

How do you want to study?

Choose a *different* activity each night you practice.

You must complete the activities for all the words that you are studying for your quiz.

Bonus – You may do activities for all twenty words!

Write the list number, title of the activity and date on the top of each page before you start.

Shaky Spelling. Write the spelling words with your right hand. Then, write them with your left hand.

Spelling Poem. Choose *at least* five words. Write a poem in your spelling journal using your spelling words. Please underline all of the spelling words that you used in the poem.

Spelling Story! Write a SHORT story in your spelling journal using your spelling words. Please underline all of the spelling words that you used in the story.

Dictionary Dig! Find 5 spelling words in the dictionary and write the definition for each one.

Super Sentences! Write three sentences using as many words as you can each time. They can be silly, but they need to be grammatically correct. Underline the spelling words in red.

Fabulous Five! Write the spelling words five times each. Use a different color each time if you'd like.

Example

1. am, am, am, am, am
2. ran, ran, ran, ran, ran
3. write, write, write, write, write

Spelling Sort! Sort your spelling words by beginning letter (consonant or vowel).

Example

<u>vowel</u>	<u>consonant</u>
am	dog
is	not

Alphabet City. Write your spelling words in alphabetical order, starting with “a”. Or, you can do it backwards, starting from “z”! Underline the letters that make the vowel sound.

Example: (read)

Simple Sentences. Pick at least 10 words and write a sentence for each one. Make sure the sentence tells about the word.

Spelling Riddles. Choose five spelling words. Write a riddle that describes each word. Example (It is small and fast. It wears a yellow and black costume. The only word it knows is, “buzz”).

Answer: A bee)
