Brightwaters Farms - Utica, NY

Brightwaters has been in existence since the 1600s in one form or another, with the Quintal family having started to run it in 1997. Since then, they have expanded it to include a dairy farm in Masonville, NY and over 60 acres of greenhouses and open fields in Utica, NY, which currently grows vegetables, plants, and shrubs.

Cayuga Pure Organics – Brooktondale, NY

Cayuga Pure Organics is a Certified Organic distributor of local beans, grains, and flours in upstate NY. Cayuga's new beanery is a passive geo-thermal building meaning that it uses ground heat as the only source for heating and cooling the building year-round. They sell delicious beans and will soon have oatmeal!

Champlain Valley Milling – Westport, NY

Champlain Valley Milling is located in Westport, NY and has been family-owned and operated since 1985. Owner Sam Sherman grew up on a nearby farm and has been learning the production practices associated with milling practically since birth. His expertise and enthusiasm for local grain has turned Champlain Valley Milling into the largest Certified Organic mill in New York.

Dagele Brothers Produce – Florida, NY

Dagele Brothers Produce farms on 400 acres in the Black Dirt region located in southern Orange County, NY. The region gets its name from the extremely dark and fertile soil there that was left over from a glacial lake bottom. Dagele Brothers is especially known for their delicious onions and lettuces.

Davenport Farms – Stone Ridge, NY

The Davenport family has been farming the land at Davenport Farms since 1840! A member of the family still works in every phase of production from harvesting to managing the roadside stand. Davenport is especially known for its delicious sweet corn, but also wholesales broccoli, tomatoes, cantaloupe, peppers, and more!

De Meyer Farm – Hilton, NY

De Meyer Farm specializes in growing specialty winter squashes including Sweet Meat and Mini Blue Hubbard. All varieties are carefully chosen and grown for the best flavor, texture and storage

Emmi & Sons Inc. - Baldwinsville, NY

Emmi & Sons is a 300 acre family owned and operated farm in Baldwinsville, NY established during World War II and incorporated in 1961. They grow fruits and vegetables such as sweet

corn, strawberries, blueberries, squash, eggplant, and apples, as well as processing beans. Emmi & Sons obtains a food safety certification every summer.

Farmer Ground Flour – Trumansburg, NY

100% certified organic grain mill located in Trumansburg, NY. At Farmer Ground Flour they select their grains for flavor and performance, and every year plant trial plots of heirloom wheat, such as "Warthog" and "Glen." They are also working with NOFA and the Northeast Organic Wheat Project to identify and promote superior heritage wheat varieties, and to develop relationships among farmers, bakers, and millers. Full Sun Company - Middlebury, VT

Full Sun is New England's first non-GMO certified oil mill, producing artisan oils with a focus on sustainability. They are Vermont Organic Farmers certified, contracting more of their oilseed from local Vermont and the Northeast each year.

Handsome Brook Farm – Various locations throughout New York

Handsome Brook Farm is a collaboration of small, mostly Amish - owned farms in upstate New York. Their eggs are produced by pasture-raised hens that are provided acres of pasture to forage, roam, and scratch in! The Cornucopia Institute gave them a 5 Egg Star (Exemplary) Rating based on several criteria including outdoor access and management, laying hen lifespan, and the nutritional quality of their feed.

L'Hommedieu Farms - Clinton, NY

L'Hommedieu is part of the Upstate Growers & Packers Cooperative, providing us with fresh cabbage and cauliflower seasonally.

Larchmont Farms - Elmer, NJ

Larchmont Farms is located in Elmer, NJ, farming 800 of its 1000 acre farm. It was incorporated in 1769 and currently operates using solar power as well as drip irrigation from wells. In an effort to decrease its use of pesticides, Larchmont instead uses mating disruption for pest control in their fields. Their ranches, harvest crews, and packing house are audited using PrimusGFS v2.1-2.

LynOaken Orchards – Medina, NY

The apple growing tradition of the Oakes family dates back to 1919 when their grandfather purchased land in rural Orleans County in Western New York State to grow the best apples possible. As stewards of the environment, LynOaken Orchards provides unwaxed, hand-packed apples and flash-pasteurized orchard fresh cider made from their own hand-picked fruit.

Marolda Farm – Vineland, NJ

Marolda Farm is owned and operated by husband and wife team Richard and Sherry Marolda. Their farm spans 415 acres (350 acres of conventional produce and 65 acres of Certified Organic) and they grow a diverse mix of greens, root veggies, herbs, nightshades, and even strawberries. Their son, Richard Jr. co-runs the farm and oversees their Certified Organic program. The Maroldas have a hand in all aspects of the farm - from seeding to watering to harvesting and beyond - and they put a lot of love into each case of produce.

Maine Grains – Skowhegan, ME

Maine Grains produces a variety of stone- milled products using locally grown and sourced grains. Through a unique stone-milling process, they are able to preserve nutritional content and improve the performance of flour for natural fermentation baking. All of their products are milled to order. Products are grown without synthetic pesticides.

Mead Orchards – Tivoli, NY

Mead Orchards is a family - owned fruit orchard and vegetable farm, located in the beautiful Hudson Valley of New York! The Mead family has been farming apples, peaches, plums, blueberries and a variety of summer vegetables since 1916.

Muzzarelli Farms – Vineland, NJ

North Country Farms – Watertown, NY

Bordered by the Adirondack Mountains and Lake Ontario, North Country Farms mills uses granite stones to produce flours from locally-grown grains.

Pastore Orchards – Elm, NJ

The original family owned business was started in 1937 and has expanded from 20 to 300 acres in its nearly 80 year history. Though Charlie continues to grow sweet potatoes and pickles as his grandfather did, he is quick to say that he doesn't take "special pride" in these two crops. "I take pride in all my crops." These crops include endive, escarole, romaine, cabbage, beets, leeks, eggplant, plum, grape, and tomatoes, and others.

Platte Creek Maple Farm – Saugerties, NY

Platte Creek Maple Farm is located in Saugerties, NY, where they sustainably produce 100% pure maple syrup! Their detailed forest management plan maintains biodiversity, productivity and regeneration capacity through practices including minimal tapping and promoting tree growth without the use of fertilizers. Platte Creek also follows guidelines for organic maple production as outlined by NOFA.

Primordia Mushroom Farm - Lenhartsville, PA

Primordia is a small family owned and operated farm in Lenhartsville, Pennsylvania. They specialize in gourmet mushroom varieties such as Lion's Mane, Oyster, and Shiitake. They grow all of their mushrooms organically, using no pesticides, fungicides, or artificial fertilizers.

Prospect Hill Orchards – Milton, NY

Prospect Hill Orchards has been in the Clarke family for over 200 years! Located in Milton, NY Prospect Hill Orchards is covered in rich loam soil - perfect for growing apples, cherries, peaches, and pears!

Radicle Farm Company - Utica, NY

In an effort to reduce material waste and land use, Radical operates in rehabilitated greenhouses, which also reduces their water and fertilizer use. They grow seasonal greens and produce, distributing their greens living to bring the garden to your table. To reduce their environmental impact further, they only ship within 400 miles of their greenhouses.

Reeves Farm – Baldwinsville, NY

Reeves Farms is dedicated to producing fresh, nutritious berries and vegetables using sustainable farming practices and is a proud member of Pride of New York. The Reeves Family has been growing vegetables for more than a century in the Baldwinsville, New York area.

Remembrance Farm – Trumansburg, NY

Remembrance Farm is a 100-acre Certified Organic and Biodynamic farm in the Finger Lakes Region run by husband and wife Emily and Nathaniel Thompson. Their attention to detail ensures a high quality and consistent product. They specialize in growing salad greens and root vegetables.

Row by Row Farm - Hurley, NY

Owned and operated by Dakota and Mira Miller, Row by Row produces vegetables and pastured chickens in Hurley, NY. They're committed to sustainable growing practices, using non-GMO seeds as well as compost, mineral-based fertilizers, and cover crops.

Sarah Nicolosi and Sons – Swedesboro, NJ

Freddy Nicolosi has been farming his 500acre farm in Southern New Jersey for over 5 decades. He grows high quality, retail ready and delicious asparagus, tomatoes, peppers, eggplants, squashes and more.

Satur Farms – Cutchogue, NY and Palm City, FL (Dec - March)

Satur Farms is based on the North Fork of Long Island where they farm from April to November before heading down to Palm City, Florida to farm during the winter months. Known for their specialty salad greens, heirloom tomatoes, root vegetables and herbs, Satur is committed to sustainable farming, not only in relation to their fields and the safe production of their vegetables, but also ensuring their employees receive livable wages.

Sorbello Farms – Woolwich Township, NJ

Sorbello Farms is a 3rd generation farm in Southern New Jersey. Owner Tom Sorbello was born and raised on the farm and has been farming for nearly his entire life. Kris, Tom's nephew, recently left his job as a middle school PE teacher to help oversee management of the farm and is enjoying spending his days outside with his dedicated farm crew. Greenmarket Co. sources their perfect asparagus and beautiful cantaloupes, among other things.

Sun Valley Orchards – Swedesboro, NJ

Founded in the early 1970's, Sun Valley Orchards is a fruit and vegetable grower, packer, and shipper in New Jersey. This 1,200 acre farm is owned and operated by the Marino family, four generations of farmers who are personally involved in every aspect of the farm-from maintaining the quality of the produce in the fields, to making sure it's hand harvested, packed with care and delivered on time in their own refrigerated trucks to assure just-picked freshness. Tassone Farms is a Cicero, NY farm that's been family-owned for 46 years! It lies on 175 acres and primarily produces peppers, tomatoes, strawberries, sweet corn, summer & winter squash, among a few others.

Toigo Orchards – Shippensburg, PA

Located in Shippensburg, PA, Toigo grows a variety of fruit including strawberries, peaches, plums, melons and apples. Willow's Cranberries – Wareham, MA

Willows Cranberries is located on Wareham, MA. Willow's grow premium quality cranberries and specializes in dry-harvesting, a technique that gently combs the berries from the vines to avoid bruising.
